that he was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment. ³⁸ She stood be-
hind him at his, weeping, and began to bathe his feet with her tears and to dry them
with her hair, kissing his feet and them with the ointment. ³⁹ Now when the Pharisee
who had invited him saw it, he said to himself, "If this man were a, he would have
known who and what kind of woman this is who is him, that she is a sinner."


